- -Stakeholder engagement to assess telehealth readiness of facilities
- -Work with stakeholders to set up needed and appropriate telehealth solutions, including and not limited to setting digital facilities, new care models, workflows and recruitment
- -Promotional and training activities to encourage uptake of telehealth solutions
- -Follow up to support facilities in the early phase of adoption
- -Work with Digital Health team to promote the use of My Health records and have resident's records up-to-date

- -Trial of after-hours plans at selected RACFs
- -Work on identification of clinical pathways to support referral to the right after hours services
