After Hours Care

Navigating patient care when your practice is closed



Accessing the right type of after hours care is essential for supporting patients who require urgent medical attention outside of regular business hours. Many patients are not aware of the after hours healthcare services available, leading to unnecessary attendance at emergency departments. GPs can improve patients' care by sharing information about how to access services after hours. Practices that share this information also meet the requirements of the RACGP
Standards for General Practices.

Many general practices in the ACT have extended hours. To direct patients to available GPs, the healthdirect Service Finder and HotDoc search function allow patients to view which practitioners have extended operating hours. Visit HealthPathways for a full list of general practices and pharmacies operating after hours including service locations.

Other options for after hours care include:

Medicare Urgent Care Clinic (UCC)

GP-led acute, episodic care for urgent but not life threatening conditions.
